

Subject

Open Repositories represents an annual opportunity to bring current and prospective Fedora developers together to review, discuss, and share:

Length

Number of attendees

The number of attendees will depend on the actual number of committers (and prospective committers) in attendance at OR-2015. It would likely be safe to reserve a space that could accommodate 25 people.

Technology and facility requirements

At a minimum, the room will need:

- wifi internet
- power

Ideally, the room would also provide:

- white-board or flip-chart
- projector for connection with our personal laptop
- conference call (mic and speaker) for remote attendees

Outcomes

These face-to-face developer meetings are critical to the cohesion of the development team, establishment of a shared vision for Fedora, and high-bandwidth sharing of designs and opportunities that are normally not afforded to our distributed team.
